## Unearth God's riches this Bible Sunday

### Welcome to your Bible Sunday resource pack!

As promised, here are your Bible Sunday 2008 resources. A treasure trove of materials to help you and your church rediscover the Bible's rich treasures.

This year's Bible Sunday theme *Buried Treasure?* is about unearthing the Bible's riches in order to know God better and live his way. Remember that Bible Sunday is officially on 26 October, but you can choose any Sunday to celebrate.

At the heart of the materials is Psalm 119, a celebration of God's words and one of the lectionary readings for 26 October for those churches which follow them.

The resources on the CD-ROM are easy to use, straightforward and adaptable to your circumstances. So you should have everything to plan a Bible Sunday service, from all-age to traditional.

You don't have to use all the resources. Simply choose what suits you and your church – for Sunday services, home groups or youth groups.
