

Undergraduate study

BA (Hons) Theology (single and combined honours)

Here at Newman we believe theology is of great importance for understanding the world in which we live. Our theology courses will extend your understanding of religion and culture, and encourage you to think about deep questions such as how human beings should live. 

BA in Theology

With a focus on mission, this programme can be taken as a one-year certificate, a two-year diploma or a three-year honours degree. Learning through lectures, seminars, placements etc. students have found their faith affirmed and helpful in giving them direction and focus as to serving God in the future.

BA in Mission and Ministry

A part-time degree, taught through intensive teaching blocks, with four streams that focus on children's mission and ministry, youth mission and ministry, third age mission and ministry and creative arts mission and ministry. Can be taken as a diploma over two years or an honours degree over four years.

Postgraduate Taught Programmes

The MA in Mission programme, taught through intensive teaching blocks, has 13 streams including Evangelism, Leadership and Renewal, Fresh Expressions/Emerging Church, Celtic Mission and Spirituality, Wesleyan Theology and Spirituality, Religious Pluralism, The World of Work, Youth Mission, Children's Mission and Christian Mentoring. Bachelor of Arts (Honours)

To access this programme a candidate must already possess an accredited degree or diploma in theology or a related subject.

Compulsory Modules: (80 Credits)

Old Testament [16 credits], New Testament [16 credits], Mini-dissertation [48 credits]

Elective Modules [Six from list) (48 credits)

MA (Research) Theology - (128 Credits)

A dissertation of not less than 30,000 words on a religious/ theological research area of the student's choice from the options provided.

MTh (Modules with Mini-Dissertation) (128 Credits)

Students must be in possession of an MDiv or equivalent qualification. Admission to this degree programme is at the discretion of the Director of Research at the NWU Faculty of Theology and is based on previous assignments and/or research results.

PhD Theology (256 credits)

The degree Doctor of Philosophy requires a thesis of 65,000 to 80,000 words and is open to those graduates who have gained a research Master's degree in Theology (or related subject) that is accredited in the internationally acknowledged sense of the word. Students with a Master's degree in Divinity (MDiv) may not automatically meet the entry requirements for PhD, but can gain access to the course by first completing a one year degree programme leading to the award of MTh (see above).
