

Activity: Masterpiece Challenge

Show six to eight pieces of art either on a PowerPoint or printed onto sheets of paper. Give the group a list of the names of the artists. The group has to try and match the artist's name with the artwork. For example, you might use the following:

- Mona Lisa – Leonardo da Vinci
- Starry Night – Vincent van Gogh
- The Scream – Eduard Munch
- The Last Supper – Leonardo da Vinci
- The Creation of Adam – Michaelangelo
- The Persistence of Memory – Salvador Dali
- Girl with a Pear Earring – Johannes Vermeer
- The Night Watch – Rembrandt
- Self Portrait without Beard – Vincent van Gogh
- Guernica – Picasso

Question: Ask the young people what they think defines a masterpiece.

Application: A masterpiece is defined by originality, its brilliance, its supremacy, because it's the creator's best work. In the Bible, God says we are his masterpiece (Ephesians 2.10)
