What's an Ambassador?

An Ambassador is someone of influence eg. Denomination or church community or larger geographical area who can promote Open the Book (OtB) as part of Bible Society using their speaking skills in various churches, venues and events. You will be encouraged to engage people as potential Storytellers, Area Co-ordinators, financial supporters or prayer partners.

What will I be doing?

You'll help share the Bible in your geographical area by:

- Seeking opportunities to promote OtB in your sphere of influence or regional area
- Connecting with Trainers and Area Co-ordinators to help promote OtB in churches
- Respond to requests to present/attend conferences or seminars
- Networking and presenting to church leaders and denominational leaders
- Helping churches fulfil their role in reaching the local community
- Having a willingness to get involved by speaking at local Christian events

How much time is involved?

We would like you to spend time speaking and contacting Christians in your area as a regular part of your diary and the more time you have available, the more you will be able to share your passion for primary school children to hear Bible stories.

What will I gain from being an Ambassador?

You'll:

- use skills and experience directly in work that builds God's kingdom and shares the Bible with primary school children
- have the satisfaction of knowing that your efforts are changing Bible Literacy knowledge in your local area
- have the opportunity to network with others in your area who have a heart to expand OtB in local primary schools
