What's a County Co-ordinator?

A County Co-ordinator is someone who actively encourages Open the Book (OtB) in their County by promoting and inspiring new teams and supporting and encouraging existing teams and networks with local Area Co-ordinators, volunteer Trainers and Ambassadors.

What will I be doing?

You'll help share the Bible in your county by:

- Actively encouraging OtB nationally to your County this could include speaking at events, churches together or denominational gatherings, manning stands at local conferences etc.
- Organise an annual get-together of the Area Co-ordinators or Team leaders
- Promote the registration and safe recruitment of teams with the OtB network
- Contact and offer encouragement to new teams (details will be provided from the OtB office)
- Work with OtB to develop an annual County plan to spread OtB and motivate and encourage existing teams.

How much time is involved?

You'll spend time each month promoting and encouraging local teams and churches. However, the more time you have available, the more you will be able to achieve.

What will I gain from being a County Co-ordinator?

You'll:

- use skills and experience directly in work that builds God's kingdom and shares the Bible with primary school children
- have the satisfaction of knowing that your efforts are changing Bible Literacy knowledge throughout the county
- be informed and supported with newsletters, updates and the website
- have the opportunity to participate in local get-togethers
- have the support and advice of the OtB office for any reports, news or information you need
